TRSD KINDERGARTEN OPTIONS

Option 1: Full-Day Kindergarten

New in 2014, TRSD has enhanced our kindergarten curriculum to offer one Full-Day Kindergarten class at each elementary school.

- A minimum of fifteen students per classroom is required in order for a full-day session to be implemented. There will also be a maximum number of students per classroom of twenty.
- If needed, a lottery will determine those students who will be chosen for full-day.

Option 2: Half-Day Kindergarten Your neighborhood elementary school continues to have kindergarten classrooms with morning or afternoon sessions available.

• Half-Day Kindergarten Program

→ Morning: 8:30-11:10→ Afternoon: 12:40-3:10



The District provides one way transportation on buses for half-day sessions (to school in the a.m.; from school in the p.m.). Parents are responsible for mid-day transportation.

Transportation for Full Day Kindergarten is provided to and from school.

Registration

All documentation for registration is located **ONLINE** and must be completed prior to **August 1**, **2015**. Please go to <u>www.danvilleschool.com</u> and follow the Kindergarten Registration link.

In addition to the forms you will be filling in online, families must also bring to the school:

Record of immunization: consistent with current state immunization requirements (RSA 200:141-C)

Proof of physical: within 1 year

Original birth certificate (with seal)

Certification of residency

*Children must be 5 years old on or before September 30th.

Philosophy

Timberlane School District recognizes its responsibility to develop skills in the areas of Reading, Language Mathematics. Arts. and The kindergarten program is aligned with the TRSD elementary curriculum. Curriculum

Full Day Tuition

The total annual cost is \$4500. The cost may be paid in full prior to June 30, 2015 or it may be paid in 10 monthly payments of \$450 each beginning August 1, 2015.

Placement Process

The full-day kindergarten class will be limited to 20 students. If the number of applications exceeds the maximum number of students for a class, a random drawing will be held to determine placement. The random drawing will involve the school principal and registrar. The following week, a letter of acceptance or non-selection will be mailed to all parents who applied.
